### **CTA-UWO Board Member Job Description**

The Board of the CTA-UWO is to be comprised of 9 elected voting members. From the pool of elected Board members, consensus within the Board will determine the President, Vice-President, and Secretary Treasurer as per the By-Laws (January 2006). The responsibilities of these specific positions are detailed within the By-Laws of CTA-UWO.

Term of Office: 2 years

The general responsibilities of the board members include:

1. Attendance at Board Meetings, which are held the week of the AMOSO (Academic Medical Organization of Southwestern Ontario) governing committee meetings.

Frequency: Usually each month, currently Wednesday evening

Duration: 1-2 hours

2. Attendance at AMOSO Governing Committee meetings

Five members will be selected as voting representatives from CTA board and alternates will be determined should voting representatives be unavailable.

Frequency: Usually each month, currently the last Friday morning

Duration: 0700-0830 h

This expectation would be in addition to the AMOSO Governing Committee.
